

Be Prepared:

1. Make a list of important items to take during evacuation: **P I P: Precious / Irreplaceable / Portable** Phone numbers, birth certificates, insurance, tax and pet documents, prescriptions, vitamins, glasses, other medical necessities, laptop/hard drives, digital media, cell phones, chargers and connectors, passwords, Credit / ATM cards, cash, jewelry, heirlooms, memorabilia.

2. Assemble emergency "GO BAG" to include water, non-perishable food, clothing / shoes, hygiene items, extra vehicle keys, flashlight and batteries.

3. Have extra cash on hand: min. (3) times cost of vehicle fuel fill up.

4. Make home inventory: collectible items, electronics, furniture, belongings; take photos / videos and place in "GO BAG". Keep an additional copy off site in a safe place.

5. Pets – make evacuation arrangements; extra food, leashes, carriers, meds, etc.

6. Ensure all family members are familiar with Emergency Egress Routes; pick evacuation destination.

7. Establish out-of-area contact person for family to relay messages.

8. Register with El Paso County Emergency Notification System. [elpasoteller911.org; Emergency Notifications]

When to leave:

Don't wait to be ordered to leave! Leave early to avoid being caught in fire, smoke or road congestion. Leaving early can prevent injury / death and helps emergency personnel / fire fighters.

Preparing your Home:

1. Close all doors / windows / vents in home.
2. Lower / close shutters / blinds. Remove flammable window drapes / curtains.
3. Move stuffed furniture away from windows.
4. Move combustible deck furniture into garage.
5. Park unused vehicles in garage.
6. Turn off propane tanks and move into garage.
7. Leave on all interior and exterior lights.
8. Leave garden hoses w/ nozzles attached. Leave water turned off.

When you leave:

Protect yourself from heat / smoke (mask and goggles), wear sturdy shoes, long pants / long sleeve shirt. Turn on headlights, keep windows rolled up. Be alert for Emergency Vehicles, pull over to let them pass.

Emergency Egress Routes:

In an emergency, Sheriff and Emergency Officials will designate incident specific Evacuation Routes.

Residents are strongly urged to become familiar with the Emergency Egress Routes outlined on the map in this pamphlet.

EMERGENCY EGRESS ROUTES

1 - MAIN:

Highway 105/Red Rock Ranch Drive (to Monument or Palmer Lake)

2 - SOUTHEAST:

A South on Red Rocks Drive, Left on Mt Herman Rd, Left on to Mitchell Ave (Monument)

B South on Sunburst Drive, Left on Mt Herman Rd, Left on Mitchell Ave (Monument)

[**A or B:** Left on Mt Herman Rd, Right on Nursery Rd, stay Right onto Schilling Ave, Left on Lindbergh Rd, Left on Mesa Top Dr, Left on Forest Lakes Dr to W Baptist Road/125]

3 - NORTHEAST:

A East on Red Rock Ranch Dr, Left on Forest View Rd, Left on Douglas Ave, Right on Trinidad Lane, Right on Greeley Blvd, Right on Spring St/Highway 105 (Palmer Lake)

B. East on Red Rock Ranch Dr, Left on Forest View Rd, Straight onto Brookridge Ave, Right on Epworth Highway, Right on Greeley Blvd, Right on Spring St/Highway 105 (Palmer Lake)
